## SOUTH KESTEVEN DISTRICT COUNCIL

## CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

*The South Kesteven District Council No. 11 (Grantham No. 27)  
Smoke Control Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that the South Kesteven District Council in exercise of powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on 27th September 1979 made an Order entitled the South Kesteven District Council No. 11 (Grantham No. 27) Smoke Control Order 1979, declaring the area described in the Schedule below to be a Smoke Control Area, which Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

By virtue of Section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building will be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at my office at St. Vincents, Grantham, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from 28th December 1979.

The Order will come into operation on 1st November 1980.

Within the period of six weeks any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Becket House, Lambeth Palace Road, London SE1 7ER, object to the confirmation of the Order.

## SCHEDULE

The area bounded by (1) South—The Centre of Brook Street North—Eastwards from its junction with North Street to its junction with the Centre of Manthorpe Road (2) East—The Centre of Manthorpe Road from its junction with the Centre of Brook Street to the Northern boundary of No. 79 Manthorpe Road, to the Eastern boundary of No. 1 Lodge Way, the Eastern and Southern boundaries of No. 1 Lodge Way, the Southern boundary of No. 2 Lodge Way, the Eastern and Southern boundaries of No. 28 Lodge Way, the Eastern boundaries of Nos. 26 and 27 Lodge Way to the Northern boundary of No. 25 Lodge Way, the Northern and Eastern boundary of No. 25 Lodge Way, the South-Eastern boundaries of No. 23 and 24 Lodge Way, the South-Western boundaries of Nos. 22, 21 and 20 Lodge Way, the Eastern boundaries of Little Gonerby House and Nos. 8, 10, 16, 18, 22, 24, 26, 28 and 30 Welby Gardens and Gregory House, Welby Gardens. (3) North—from the junction of the Eastern and Northern boundaries of Gregory House, westwards to the Centre of North Parade immediately south of the Railway Bridge. (4) West—the Centre of North Parade immediately south of the Railway Bridge, the Centre of North Street to its junction with Brook Street.
