Motor cars and motor cycles with side cars:

For the period starting on 1st April and ending on 31st October:

Between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Up to 5 hours—20p

5 to 10 hours—30p

Between 6 p.m. and 8 a.m.

For any period—20p

A season ticket valid only at the Pier Car Park, Southwold, for the period starting on 1st April and ending on 31st October—available only for hirers of the chalet sites £5.

## SOUTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(Wicker, Sheffield) (Prohibition of Right Hand Turns)  
(Experimental) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that on 20th December 1979 the South Yorkshire County Council made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974.

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on 2nd January 1980 will be to prohibit any vehicle which is proceeding in a south-westerly direction in Wicker at Sheffield from making a right hand turn into Stanley Street.

A copy of the Order together with a map showing the restricted road may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of (i) the County Council, County Hall, Barnsley and (ii) County Engineer, Cambridge House, Division Street, Sheffield.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulations Act, 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from 20th December 1979 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## HARLOW DISTRICT COUNCIL

The District of Harlow (Town Centre—Velizy Avenue)  
(Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order, 1980

Notice is hereby given that The District Council of Harlow propose to make an Order under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

It is proposed to construct an exclusive 'right-hand' turn facility from Velizy Avenue into East Gate which will be traffic signal controlled.

When the Order comes into effect, it will restrict access to all vehicles, except P.S.V's and emergency service vehicles, from entering East Gate travelling southwards on Velizy Avenue.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order which together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined (free of charge) at the Town Hall, Harlow between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Friday.
