Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Anglian Water Authority, Essex River Division, by Strutt and Parker (Farms) Ltd., Whitelands, Hatfield Peverel, Chelmsford, Essex, for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from the River Brain between the following points for Spray Irrigation use:

40,000 cubic metres (approximately 8.7 million gallons) per annum between National Grid map reference points TL 794 178 and TL 798 174 at Faulkbourne Farms in the parish of Faulkbourne, Witham, Essex.

The abstraction will be supported by water discharged under the Ely Ouse/Essex Water Transfer Scheme.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

DOVER DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Borough of Dover (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and One-Way Traffic) (1974) (Amendment) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of Dover with the consent of the Kent County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19, to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974.

The effect of the Order will be:—

(1) to prohibit waiting at any time in certain lengths of High Street, Lower Road and Mill Street, Temple Ewell, Clarence Place and Edwards Road;

(2) to prohibit waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on every day except Sundays in certain lengths of Bartholomew Street, Churchill Street, Clarence Place, Granville Street and Lorne Road;

(3) to limit waiting to 1 hour in any period of 3 hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on all days in certain lengths of the un-named road to the west of Southern House;

(4) to introduce a one-way traffic flow in Edwards Road.

Dover District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (1976) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1980

GOSPORT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Gosport (Portsmouth Road (part), Lee on the Solent) (Bus Stop) (Clearway) Order (No. 1) 1980

Notice is hereby given that the Gosport Borough Council acting in accordance with arrangements made by Hampshire County Council under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, for the exercise in the Borough of Gosport of certain powers of the County Council, proposes to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3), (3B) and (6) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The purpose of the Order is to prohibit vehicles, other than buses, from waiting between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day at any bus stop in that part of the road specified below where the carriageway at that stop is marked (a) as a bus stop, and (b) with a broad yellow line adjacent to the edge of the carriageway ("the authorised markings"):

Portsmouth Road (part) between its junction with Raynes Road and its junction with South Place, Lee on the Solent.

Although the Order includes every bus stop in the road specified above, it should be noted that the provisions of the Order which prohibit waiting will apply only to the bus stop which the Council marks with the authorised markings.

While the Order remains in force it enables the Council at any time to lay or to remove the authorised markings at or from any bus stop in a specified road or to adjust the position in that road of the authorised markings, as traffic conditions may require.
