NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY PUBLIC PATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1959—SECTION 111

The North Yorkshire County Council Footpath No. 4A Thorpe Willoughby Parish and Footpath No. 1/2 Brayton Parish Diversion Order 1978

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to paragraph 2 (3) of the Seventh Schedule to the Highways Act 1959, that the Secretary of State for the Environment proposes to modify the North Yorkshire County Council Footpath No. 4A Thorpe Willoughby Parish and Footpath No. 1/2 Brayton Parish Diversion Order 1978 by providing that instead of the alternative path proposed by the Order which commences at a point 325 metres east of Thorpe Gates proceeding north across field OS No. 4632 and 5036 for 35 metres then turning east on the southern side of the railway boundary fence across field OS Nos. 5036, 8435 and 1334 for a distance of 1,000 metres to its junction with Brackenhill Lane south of Sandhill Gates to the north of Brayton; the alternative route shall commence from a point on the existing footpath at the north-eastern corner of OS field No. 6218 and follow the line of a dismantled railway in a south-easterly direction for approximately 900 metres and then turning north-north-easterly along a track following the eastern boundary of field OS No. 3400 for a distance of approximately 150 metres to rejoin the existing path at the north-east corner of that field; the remainder of the route to Brayton following the existing footpath.
