#### COMPENSATION FOR AIRCRAFT AND SHIPBUILDING INDUSTRIES

On behalf of Her Majesty's Treasury the Bank of England announce that, in accordance with the Aircraft and Shipbuilding Industries Act 1977, an issue of about £3.67 million of 10 per cent. Exchequer Stock 1983 was made on 11th March 1980 as a further payment on account of compensation in respect of the unquoted securities of Vickers Shipbuilding Group Ltd.

This follows the announcement on 4th March 1980 by the Department of Industry.

The issue of 10 per cent. Exchequer Stock 1983 will be at the rate of £100 Exchequer Stock per £85 13/16 compensation.

The stock issued on 11th March will rank for a full six months' interest on 12th June 1980 and will not be distinguished from 10 per cent. Exchequer Stock already in being. A special interest payment will be made covering the period from 1st July 1977 to 12th December 1979.

Dealings in the stock commenced on 12th March 1980.
