

2. The general effect of the Hackney (Bus Lane) (No. 1, 1979) (Amendment No. 1) Traffic Order 1980 will be to amend the Hackney (Bus Lane) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1979 so as to allow vehicles being used to deliver or collect postal packets, in certain circumstances to use the Mare Street bus lane.

3. The general effect of the Hackney (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 26) Order 1980 will be further to amend the Hackney (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977 so that the hours during which the existing prohibition applies on:—

- (a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be changed so that it will apply—
- (i) between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of street specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice ;
- (ii) between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. on Saturdays in the length of street specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice ;
- (b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle will be changed so that it will apply—
- (i) between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of street specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice ;
- (ii) between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. on Saturdays in the length of street specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice ;
- (c) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be changed so that it will apply, unless otherwise prohibited as above, in the length of Mare Street referred to in sub-paragraph (a) (i) and (ii) above during the hours of operation specified in relation to each of the said lengths of Mare Street.

4. A copy of each of the Orders, which will come into operation on 31st March 1980, and of the above-mentioned

Orders of 1977 and 1979 (and of the Orders which have previously amended the Order of 1977) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made in Room B21, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

5. Copies of the Orders may be purchased from the Information Centre, Greater London Council, The County Hall, SE1 7PB.

6. Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to either of the Orders may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
