Haunton-Clifton Campville Road, Stopping-up of part of Highway Verge

Notice is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council intend to apply to the Tamworth Magistrates' Court sitting at the Court House, Spinning School Lane, Tamworth, on 8th July 1980 at 10 a.m. for an Order that part of the highway verge on the south side of the Haunton-Clifton Campville Road from a point opposite the east end of the barn east of Newhouse Farm eastwards for a distance of 117 metres be authorised to be stopped-up on the ground that it is unnecessary.

The following persons have the right to be heard at the Hearing of the Council's application:

- (i) Any person upon whom this Notice has been served.
- (ii) Any person who uses the highway.
- (iii) Any other person who would be aggrieved by the making of the Order applied for.

The West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council (Colne Valley Footpath No. 10) Public Path Extinguishment Order 1979.

Notice is hereby given that on 18th March 1980 the West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council confirmed the above-named Order.

Its effect is to extinguish the public right of way running from its junction with Hey Lane, Scammonden, at map reference 0603 1645 in a northerly direction for approximately 60 yards to the southern boundary of the M62 Motorway at map reference 0603 1650 being part of Path No. 10 in the former Colne Valley Urban District.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited at the Reception Desk, County Hall, Wakefield, and at the Town Hall, Slaithwaite, and may be there inspected free of charge during office hours on Mondays to Fridays.

The Order becomes operative as from 18th March 1980 but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may under Schedule 2 to the Act, as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 of the Act, within 6 weeks from 31st March 1980 make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
