NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Nottinghamshire County Council (A6065 Beastmarket Hill and Great North Road, Newark) (Parking Places and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980.

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effects of which will be:

- (1) No person shall cause any vehicle to wait at any time in parts of the following roads at Newark in the District of Newark:

Beastmarket Hill (A6065 and Great North Road) A6065;

- (2) No person shall cause any vehicle to wait in the following length of road between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.:

Beastmarket Hill, north-east side, extending from the centre line The Old Wharf in a south-easterly direction to the south-eastern boundary of The Ossington, a distance of 49 metres measured along the said length of road.

- (3) The following length of road will be designated as a Parking Place allowing vehicles to wait there for up to 30 minutes between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on all days. Parking there will be confined to motor cars and motor cycles, in appropriately marked out bays. The Order will include a provision that no person shall use a vehicle, while it is in the parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of skills or services:

Beastmarket Hill, Newark, south-west side, on the cobbled area commencing 28 metres from Castle Gate

(A46) junction in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 53 metres.

- (4) The following Order will be amended in accordance with the above:

The Borough of Newark-on-Trent (Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) (and Revocation) Order 1971.

The usual exemptions will be provided in connection with all the above proposals. Relevant documents may be inspected at my office or at the library, Castle Gate, Newark-on-Trent, Nottinghamshire, or at the office of the Chief Legal and Administrative Officer, Newark District Council, Kelham Hall, Newark, Nottinghamshire. 3. That length of *Saracen's Head Yard* which extends for a distance of 35 yards from its junction with the Market Place.

4. The whole of the highways in the *Market Place* with the exception of that portion of the highway which runs from the White Hart yard to the front of Porter's shop.

The Preseli District Council (Haverfordwest) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1980
