*The London—South Wales Motorway (M4) (Coryton, Cardiff)
(Speed Limit) Regulations 1980*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made the above Regulations. They will have the effect of imposing a 40 m.p.h. speed limit on the lengths of motorway specified in the Schedule to this Notice. The Regulations shall, subject to Parliament's powers of annulment, come into operation on 8th August 1980.

SCHEDULE

1. That length of the eastbound exit slip road of the Coryton Interchange at Cardiff in the county of South Glamorgan which extends from its junction with the Cardiff-Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) in a westerly direction for a distance of 196 metres.

2. That length of the westbound exit slip road of the Coryton Interchange at Cardiff in the county of South Glamorgan which extends from its junction with the Cardiff-Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 300 metres.
