THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968 (AS AMENDED)

Switzerland: Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly give notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97), as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973 and 1979 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351 and S.I. 1979 1426), and the Transfer of Functions (Wales) (No. 1) Order 1978 (S.I. 1978 No. 272) they hereby restrict recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the Schedule to the Notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 7th January 1969 for the importation of meat and meat products from Switzerland, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The Notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 8th March 1980 is hereby revoked.
