#### AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

(Weston-super-Mare, District of Woodspring) (Traffic Regulation) (Amendment No. 6) Order 1980

**SOUTH GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL**

*The County Council of South Glamorgan (Cardiff Central Area) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1980*

  - (c) *St. Mary Street* on its north-east side from a point 15.2 metres south-east of its junction with Wharton Street south-east for a distance of 73.2 metres and from a point 35.2 metres north-west of its junction with Wharton Street north-west for a distance of 38.1 metres;
- (iii) to prevent you from driving any vehicle so that it makes a right-hand turn from the north bound carriageway of Kingsway into the Kingsway Service Road and from the Kingsway Service Road into the north bound carriageway of Kingsway.

2. (a) There will be no exemption for access to 1 (i) above other than for statutory undertakers, and disabled persons issued with "Restricted Mobility Permits" who will be allowed to use the roads up to 12 noon;

- (b) Exemptions to 1 (ii) above will be permitted for the following reasons:
  - (i) boarding and alighting from a vehicle;
  - (ii) loading and unloading of goods;
  - (iii) essential services and funerals;
  - (iv) for a maximum period of two hours vehicles when displaying an "Orange Badge" and being used for the conveyance of disabled persons.
