Cattewater Road Slip Road East, from its junction with Laira Bridge Road Link Road to its junction with Cattewater Road Slip Road West.

The County of Durham (Branch Library Access Road, Durham City) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order

Notice is hereby given that the Durham County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Local Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting by vehicles at any time on any day on the sides of road at Durham City in the City of Durham District specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The Order will contain exemptions in respect of boarding and alighting; loading and unloading of goods; building, industrial or demolition operations and the removal of obstructions to traffic; maintenance of the roads; delivery or collection of postal packets; vehicles being used in pursuance of statutory powers; police, fire brigade, ambulance and disabled drivers' vehicles.
