The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert the public right of way running for a distance of 470 metres in length and 2 metres in width at Bursom Industrial Park, Beaumont Leys, Leicester and shown coloured blue on the map, to a line 535 metres in length and 2 metres in width on land situate at Bursom Industrial Park, Beaumont Leys, Leicester and shown coloured green on the map.
