## HONOURS AND AWARDS

The QUEEN has been graciously pleased, on the advice of Her Majesty's Fiji Ministers, to approve the award of the Military Cross in recognition of services with the Fiji Infantry Regiment serving in the Lebanon as part of the United Nations Peacekeeping Force.

Military Cross

Lieutenant Savenaca Uluibau Draunidalo (21680) Fiji Infantry Regiment.

On 22nd August 1979 a checkpoint situated on an important road junction was attacked by over 20 Armed Elements using automatic weapons and rocket propelled grenades (RPG). Reinforcements mounted in armoured personnel carriers from a neighbouring battalion were halted by RPG fire short of the checkpoint and could not effectively contribute to its defence. Immediately assessing the danger to the checkpoint and the section manning it, Lt. Draunidalo manned a General Purpose Machine Gun (GPMG) (sustained fire) on the roof of a nearby building and engaged a group of 15-20 who were assaulting the checkpoint from the West. He caused them heavy casualties. The support he provided was so effective that this

assault was halted and the group withdrew. The Armed Elements retreated towards Lt. Draunidalo's position, but, in keeping with the United Nations Rules of Engagement in such situations, Lt. Draunidalo fired over the heads of the retreating force thus avoiding unnecessary deaths once it was clear the assault had failed. There is no doubt that the integrity of the checkpoint was saved by Lt. Draunidalo's effective and timely intervention and his subsequent action avoided challenges as to the degree of force used by the UN.

Two days later, after moving to another location to assume command of two platoons at another threatened checkpoint, Lt. Draunidalo's escort was ambushed a short distance from where he left the vehicles; three soldiers were killed and two wounded. Lt. Draunidalo took command of the UN elements in the area and quickly won the respect of all. Lt. Draunidalo's subsequent role in negotiating at grave confrontations between United Nations troops and volatile adversaries resolved matters without prejudicing the integrity of his unit's mission. Lt. Draunidalo's presence in the Al Bazuriah area was largely responsible for its subsequent stability.

Throughout his one year tour Lt. Draunidalo was a constant source of inspiration to those who served with him. His diligence, bravery and dedication were in the highest traditions of the Infantry and significantly contributed to the achievement of the United Nations Mission in his unit's operational area. (3) The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if this Scheme were an Act of Parliament.

## PART II. GENERAL CONDITIONS

#### Reception for transmission

3. An Intelpost item may be handed in at any post office from time to time designated for that purpose by the Post Office, or it may be handed to a Post Office messenger authorised to receive it in which case the sender shall pay the appropriate charge for this facility as prescribed by scheme, in addition to all charges for the use of the Intelpost Service.

4. (1) The sender of an Intelpost item shall furnish the name and address of the person to whom it is to be delivered in accordance with the provisions of the following

sub-paragraphs.

(2) The address shall be in such form as will enable the Intelpost item to be delivered without difficulty or the need to make enquiries and with due regard to any relevant requirement of the postal authority in the country of destination.

(3) The address shall be one which falls within a delivery area from time to time defined by the relevant postal

authority.

(4) The address shall be furnished in the language or one of the languages of the country of destination provided this is written in Roman characters.

#### Particulars of sender

5. The sender shall supply with any document tendered for transmission by Intelpost his name and the full address (including where possible a telephone number) to which the originals of such documents may be returned and to which any enquiries connected with the relevant Intelpost items may be made.

#### Objectionable documents

6. No Intelpost item shall be delivered or tendered for transmission if in the opinion of the Post Office it contains anything which is libellous or is grossly offensive or of an indecent, obscene, or menacing character.

## Limits of size and quality

7. No Intelpost item tendered for transmission by Intelpost may exceed 210mm × 297mm in size or have an all round margin of less than 10 millimetres. If in the opinion of the Post Office, an item tendered is unsuitable for transmission by reason of its quality, it may nevertheless be sent provided the sender, having been so advised, indicates his wish for transmission to proceed.

## Stoppages of certain Intelpost items

8. (1) The Post Office may refuse or stop the transmission of an Intelpost item which does not in its opinion

### Return and forwarding of original items

9. Special collection charges

12. Where a service comparable to the Post Office's Expresspost service is available in the country of destination of an Intelpost item and the sender requests delivery by that service, he shall pay the appropriate charge as fixed from time to time by the Post Office.

Mode of payment of charges

13.—(1) All charges in respect of transmission and of all other services provided in connection therewith shall (except as herein provided or as the Post Office may direct) be prepaid by the sender.

(2) Intelpost items may be accepted for transmission without prepayment if the sender has made prior arrangements with the Post Office for a credit account.

Remission of charges

14. The Post Office may remit or refund in whole or in part any sum payable or paid under this Scheme in such cases as it may determine but no refund shall be made in respect of an Intelpost item which the sender has requested the Post Office to transmit after having been warned by it that the item is of a reproducing quality which in the opinion of the Post Office is unsuitable for transmission by Intelpost.
