Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in, the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any instrument made under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of 18th June 1980, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE 1

No waiting at any time with exemptions

Eastern access of the lay-by

(a) East side, from the southern kerb-line of the main carriageway of the A63 trunk road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres;

(b) West side, from the southern kerb-line of the main carriageway of the A63 trunk road southward then westwards for a total distance of 12 metres.

Western end of the lay-by

(a) North side of the egress road from the southern kerb-line of the main carriageway of the A63 trunk road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 35 metres;

(b) South side of the egress road from the southern kerb-line of the main carriageway of A63 trunk road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 50 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

No waiting midnight to 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. to midnight for vehicles over 2 tons unladen weight with exemptions

(a) West side, from a point 12 metres south-west of the southern kerb-line of the A63 trunk road in a westerly direction for a distance of 107 metres.

(b) East side, from a point 15 metres south-west of the southern kerb-line of the A63 trunk road in a westerly direction for a distance of 118 metres. (14 SI)

The Trunk Road (Welton, near Hull (A63)) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, on the Liverpool-Leeds-Hull (A63) Trunk Road.

The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 1st July 1980, is to prohibit waiting:

(i) as specified in the attached Schedules in the lay-by at Welton which is situated to the south of the main carriageway of the trunk road, extends from its junction with the trunk road in a westerly direction for a distance measured along that part of the trunk road of 200 metres, and is located 15 kilometres west of Hull; and

(ii) at any time in the service road providing access to Pool Bank Cottages and Pool Bank Farm leading from the southern side of the said lay-by in a westerly direction for a distance of 73 metres.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle or to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the lay-by or the Services therein.
