The South Yorkshire County Council (Church Street, Conisbrough) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that on 16th June 1980 the South Yorkshire County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on 1st July 1980 will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the northern and north-western side of Church Street, Conisbrough in the Metropolitan District of Doncaster which extends from its junction with the eastern kerb-line of North Cliff Road for a distance of 205 metres in an easterly and north-easterly direction.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the road and the services therein, in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for the collection and delivery of postal packets. The usual exceptions for disabled persons' vehicles are also included in the Order.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads the subject of the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of (i) the County Council, County Hall, Barnsley and (ii) Conisbrough Branch Library, Rowena Annexe, Morley Place, Conisbrough, near Doncaster.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 16th June 1980 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

WEST YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council (Leeds) (Traffic Regulation) (No. 10) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council have made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.
