CREWE AND NANTWICH BOROUGH COUNCIL

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971, SECTION 210

Crewe and Nantwich Borough Council (Parker's Road/Bradfield Road) Public Path Diversion Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that this Order, made on 25th June is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the Crewe and Nantwich Borough Council.

The effect of the Order if confirmed without modification will be to divert some 327 yards of the existing public right of way, in a generally north-west to south-easterly direction, between that section which commences 10 yards from the south side of Parker's Road to henceforth run in a meandering fashion on average 14 yards from the fence adjoining the main Crewe-Liverpool railway line and ending at a point some 17 yards west of this track.

This diversion is necessary to facilitate residential development at Coppenhall Park Estate, Crewe, as authorised in accordance with Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
