### THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968 (AS AMENDED)

#### *United States of America : Official Certificate*

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly give notice, that in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97), as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973 and 1979 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351 and S.I. 1979 No. 1426) and the Transfer of Functions (Wales) (No. 1) Order 1978 (S.I. 1978 No. 272) they hereby restrict recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the First Schedule to the Notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 3rd December 1974 for the importation of poultry meat from the United States of America to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The Schedule to the Notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 1st May 1980 is hereby revoked.
