The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Non-Effective Benefits and Family Pensions) Order 1980:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865 (1865 c. 73) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The said Order shall be amended, in Schedule III thereto, by deleting Clause 1 and substituting the following:

"1. The provisions of this Schedule relate to officers and ratings who gave service on or after 31st March 1975 and who were retired or discharged without eligibility for immediate retired pay or pension. Provided they have given a minimum period of either 5 years' reckonable or 5 years' contracted-out service they may be awarded a preserved pension at the rates shown in Clause 3 below. These provisions do not apply to officers serving on gratuity-earning short service engagements."

2. This Order may be cited as the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Non-Effective Benefits and Family Pensions) (Amendment) Order 1980.
