

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of lengths of Keeton's Hill and Wright's Hill, Sheffield, to enable development, consisting of a public car park, to be carried out by City of Sheffield Metropolitan District Council under Part III of the said Act.

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO VARY A LICENCE TO
ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that proposals are being made by the Wessex Water Authority, to vary the licence (number 13/44/58/100) which authorises the abstraction of water from underground strata at Empool, in the Parish of West Knighton in the District of West Dorset (national grid reference SY 742 878).

The proposal is to rationalise the existing licence in respect of prescribed flow requirements in the Watergates Stream and the Tadnol Brook by deleting all references to the former Watergates watercress beds and the Warmwell watercress beds. The resultant prescribed flow in the two watercourses downstream of the watercress beds would not be altered, and it is not proposed to vary the quantities of water authorised to be abstracted at Empool by this licence and licence of right number 13/44/58/11.

It is proposed to revoke these licences and to grant a new licence giving effect to the variation in their place.

A copy of the proposals and any map, plan or other documents prepared in connection with them may be inspected free of charge at the following offices of the Wessex Water Authority at all reasonable hours beginning on 16th July 1980, and ending on 13th August 1980.

After the expiry of the said period the Authority will be entitled to pass a resolution by virtue of which a licence authorising the proposals shall be deemed to be granted unless the Secretary of State for the Environment either in consequence of any representations made with respect to the proposals or otherwise, requires the application to be made to him.
