DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of an irregular shaped length of the southern footway and part of the adjoining carriageway of Sheen Road, Richmond-upon-Thames to enable development consisting of offices, flats, public open space and a pedestrian access way to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to the Confederation Life Insurance Company.

The proposed Order will require the provision of a new footpath maintainable at the public expense, for which the highway authority is to be the Greater London Council.

During 28 days from 1st August 1980 copies of the draft Order and relevant plans may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the Old Town Hall, Whitaker Avenue, Richmond-upon-Thames, Surrey and may be obtained free of charge from the Department of Transport (quoting GLRT 38/5028/7/010) at the address stated below.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping Up of Highways (London Borough of Islington) (No. 2) Order 1980" authorising the stopping up of a length of Rawstorne Place, London E.C.1, and requiring the provision of a new footpath.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following two orders:

First Order (Ref. GLRT 38/5010/7/04)—under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of Grove Place, Bakers Lane and Doncaster Road, London W.5, and lengths of Western Road, Oxford Road, and the passageway between High Street and Bakers Lane to enable development consisting of shops, offices, hotel library, leisure centre, Post Office, public house, housing, public conveniences, banking, stores, electricity sub station, parking, servicing, entertainment facilities, pedestrian and vehicular ways and ancillary uses to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to John Laing Development Services Ltd. The proposed Order will require the improvement of Oxford Road, Western Road and Grove Road by widening.

Second Order (Ref. GLRT 38/5010/9/04)—under section 212 of the above Act, on the application of the Ealing London Borough Council, to provide for the extinguishment (with exceptions) of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of Oxford Road, London W.5.
