

RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS BY THE PUBLIC WORKS LOAN COMMISSIONERS TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES

NOTICE

The Treasury hereby give notice that in accordance with the powers conferred upon them by the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 c. 13) on or after 23rd August 1980:

I. Different rates of interest shall be charged on loans made by the Public Works Loan Commissioners according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.L.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);

II. The rates of such interest shall be—

Loans to local authorities as defined in paragraph 1 of Schedule 4 to the said Act.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping up of the lengths of highways described in the Schedule to this notice to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of that Act.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 22nd August 1980, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

The lengths of highway to be stopped up are at Craig, Pontypridd in the Borough of Taff-Ely in the County of Mid Glamorgan and are:

1. That length of Rickards Street from its junction with Lewis Street in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 150 metres;
2. That length of footpath which extends from its junction with Union Street in a general southerly direction to its junction with Rickards Street and continuing in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Craig Terrace. (9 SI)
