WINDSOR AND MAIDENHEAD ROYAL BOROUGH COUNCIL

CONTROL OF POLLUTION ACT 1974

Notice of Noise Abatement Order

Notice is hereby given that the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under section 63 of The Control of Pollution Act 1974 did on 11th June 1979 make an Order known as the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead Noise Abatement Order 1980. The area contained within Norden Road, Maidenhead, the A423 (M) and the portion of railway track running between Norden Road and the A423 (M), and outlined in red on the "map referred to in the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead Noise Abatement Order 1980", is by the order declared to be a noise abatement zone.

The Order will be brought into operation one month from the date of confirmation by the Secretary of State. The general effect of the Order will be to control noise levels within the said area from premises of the following classes: industrial premises; commercial premises.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BOLTON METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Greater Manchester County (Darbshire Street, Slater Lane and Arch Street, Bolton) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Borough) (No.) Order 1980.

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Bolton acting on behalf of the Greater Manchester County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of this proposed Order will be as follows:

Prohibition of waiting at all times

Slater Lane, both sides from Waterloo Street to the north side of Darbshire Street.

Darbshire Street, both sides, for its full length.

Arch Street, both sides, from Darbshire Street to a point 40 metres south of its junction with Longson Street.

(This Order will contain exceptions to permit waiting for certain purposes and limited waiting by disabled persons' vehicles.)
