Notice is hereby given that the South Yorkshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to amend the South Yorkshire County Council (Barnsley Urban Area) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 1980 insofar as it relates to certain items in:

Schedule Three Prohibition of Waiting at any time.

Schedule Five ... Restriction of Waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday (inclusive).

Schedule Eleven One-Way Streets. ... Prohibited Turns. Schedule Thirteen

and introducing a new Schedule:

Schedule Thirteen A ... Prescribed Turns.
The following are the proposed amendments to the Parent Order: In Schedule 3 it is proposed to delete the following items:

Doncaster Road (i) Both sides from a point 61 metres west of its junction with Grange Lane/Wombwell

Lane to a point 61 metres east of that junction.

From its junction with Doncaster Road (A635) for a distance of 61 metres.

From its junction with Doncaster Road (A635) for a distance of 61 metres. Grange Lane.. Wombwell Lane (A633) (Stairfoot) ... From its junction In Schedule 3 it is proposed to add the following items:

Link Road (Doncaster Road to Doncaster Road Service Road, Eastern Leg).

Both sides from the south-eastern kerb-line of Doncaster Road Service Road (Eastern Leg) to a point 15 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Doncaster Road (A635).

Doncaster Road Service Road (Western Leg).

South side from a point 23 metres west of the western kerb-line of Bridge Street for a distance of 28 metres measured in a westerly direction.

Link Road (Doncaster Road to Doncaster Road Service Road, Western Leg).

Both sides from the southern kerb-line of Doncaster Road Service Road (Western Leg) to a point 15 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Doncaster Road (A635).

Hunningley Lane (to be called Hunningley Court).

Both sides from its northern termination for a distance of 18 metres measured in a southerly direction.

Stanley Road

Both sides from its northern termination for a distance of 13 metres in a southerly direction.

In Schedule 5 it is proposed to delete the following items:

Restriction of Waiting by vehicles between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive

Doncaster Road

(i) North side from a point 43 metres west of its junction with Gordon Street to a point 61 metres west of its junction with Grange Lane.
(ii) North side from a point 10 metres west of its junction with the western kerb-line of School Street for a distance of 70 metres in an easterly direction.
(iii) South side from a point 10 metres west of its junction with the western side of Darton Street to a point 61 metres west of its junction with Wombwell Lane.

ningley Lane ... From its junction with Doncaster Road (A635) for a distance of 14 metres. In Schedule 11 it is proposed to include the following items: Hunningley Lane Stanley Road

Schedule 13A-Prescribed Turns-will be a new Schedule to the Parent Order, in which it is proposed to cause vehicle to make a left hand turn when proceeding in the lengths of road mentioned in column 1 below, into the length of road mentioned in column 2.
