THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968, AS AMENDED

SOUTH WEST AFRICA/NAMIBIA: OFFICIAL CERTIFICATE

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly together give notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97) as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973 and 1979 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351 and S.I. 1979 No. 1426) and the Transfer of Functions (Wales) (No. 1) Order 1978 (S.I. 1978 No. 272) they hereby recognise, subject to the conditions hereinafter set out, the Official Certificate of which particulars are given in the Schedule hereto as showing—

- (a) that the meat to which it relates, or the meat to which the meat product to which it relates was prepared, was derived from mammals inspected before and after death in the country of origin of the meat and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Minister, and
- (b) that the dressing, packing and other preparation of the meat or the meat product was carried out with all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to health.

1. Recognition of the Official Certificate is extended to include:—

Portions of carcasses, with or without bone, which contain no associated lymphatic gland, or from which has been removed in preparing or trimming the meat any pleura, peritoneum or lymphatic gland.

This recognition does not extend to boneless veal appearing to an authorised officer to be from calves less than three months old.

2. The said Certificate is recognised subject to the following conditions:—

(a) This recognition applies to meat and meat products imported from South West Africa/Namibia.

(b) Where the Official Certificates are in the form of labels, the recognition will apply only if the labels are securely affixed to the meat or the meat product or the package containing the meat or the meat product, and if the labels have not in any circumstances or on any other occasion been used as Official Certificates.

(c) Where the Official Certificate is in the form of a stamp, the recognition will apply only if the stamp is clearly impressed or otherwise marked on the meat or the meat product and the package containing the meat or the meat product.

The Notices published in the *London Gazette* dated 9th March 1962 and 26th November 1968 will remain in force until 1st November 1980 from which date they will be revoked.

NOTE. Imports of uncooked meat and meat products from certain countries are restricted, and in some cases prohibited, on animal health grounds by the Importation of Animal Products and Poultry Products Order 1980. The recognition of an Official Certificate for public health purposes does not give exemption from such restrictions or prohibitions.
