Act 1967 as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from 16th October 1980 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

To prohibit waiting on the east side of High Street, Macclesfield, between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive for a distance of 18 metres from its junction; with Park Street.
