NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

High Street, Stone, Staffordshire

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf has made an Order entitled "The District of Stafford (Footpath No. 38, High Street, Stone) Public Path Diversion Order 1980" the effect of which will be to divert that part of the Footpath No. 38 at Stone which runs from High Street, approximately 25 yards north-west of its junction with Stafford Street, for a distance of approximately 17 feet in a south-westerly direction and to create an alternative highway in lieu starting at that point and running for a distance of approximately 8 feet in a south-easterly direction and then in a north-easterly direction, parallel to the existing path, for a distance of approximately 13 feet to join the existing footway approximately 5 feet south-east of the south side of High Street.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the offices of the Department of the Environment, Five Ways Tower, Frederick Road, Edgbaston, Birmingham B15 1SJ, and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Stafford Borough Council, Civic Offices, Riverside, Stafford, during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from the date of publication of this notice but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the Order he may, under section 244 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
