AUTHORITY FOR THE VARIATION OF A LICENCE
TO ABSTRACT WATER**

Notice is hereby given that the Thames Water Authority have made proposals for the variation of licence to abstract water Serial No. 28/39/41/12, which authorises the abstraction of water by means of wells and boreholes from the chalk stratum at the Authority's Waddon Pumping Station, Waddon Way, Croydon, Surrey at National Grid Reference TQ 314 639.

The variation proposed is to authorise the abstraction of 80 million gallons in every period of 30 days instead of the quantity of 50 million gallons authorised to be abstracted in every such period under the above licence. The effect of this variation will be to renew for a further period of five years until 13th May 1986 the terms of an existing variation whose authority terminates on 13th May 1981. No change is being sought in the hourly, daily and annual quantities at present authorised to be abstracted.

Notice is hereby given that the Ceredigion District Council, acting in their capacity as Coast Protection Authority, under subsection (1) of section 5 of the above Act propose to carry out coast protection works as described herein at Victoria Terrace, Aberystwyth.

The work will consist of a Beach Nourishment Scheme whereby the beach will be recharged during the winter of 1980-81 by some 2,000 cubic metres of gritstone followed in the winters of the two subsequent years by 1,000 cubic metres in each year.
