The South Yorkshire County Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Barnsley) Order 1978 (Amendment No. 2) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the South Yorkshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), (2) and (3), 28(1), 31(1), 36, 37, 39 and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to delete Schedule 1, Part II, from the South Yorkshire County Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Barnsley) Order 1978 and to substitute therefor, the items specified in the Schedule to this notice.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the restricted road and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of (i) the County Council, County Hall, Barnsley and (ii) Central Library, Shambles Street, Barnsley.
