

consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C (1), have on 20th October 1980 made the above Order, the effect of which will be:

To prohibit waiting at any time in Lower Canal Parade area, Newport, for distances as set out in Schedule 1 to this Notice.

Exemptions have been included in the Order for:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers
- (b) loading or unloading goods
- (c) delivery or collection of postal packets
- (d) the maintenance of the roads
- (e) the supply of gas, water, electricity and of any telegraphic line
- (f) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
- (g) disabled persons parking
- (h) police, fire brigade and ambulance services
- (i) a funeral.

To prohibit vehicles from proceeding in this length of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this notice in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in column 2 of that Schedule.

The Order will come into operation on 28th November 1980.

The Order and a map showing the affected roads may be inspected at the County Hall, Cwmbran, during normal office hours (Monday to Friday only).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 20th October 1980 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Canal Parade

GWENT COUNTY COUNCIL

The Gwent County Council (Various Roads, Llanyrafon, Cwmbran) (Weight Restriction) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the Gwent County Council in exercise of their powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967, have on 20th October 1980 made an Order, the effect of which will be:

To prohibit, subject to certain exceptions, any vehicle the unladen weight of which exceeds 3 tons, to proceed

in those lengths of road set out in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions are provided in the Order to permit access for the purposes of:

1. The conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to those lengths of road set out in the Schedule;
2. Agricultural in connection with land adjacent to those lengths of road set out in the Schedule, or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
3. Building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the length of road set out in the Schedule, the removal of obstructions to traffic the maintenance of the roads or the laying, erection or alteration of sewers, mains, pipes or telegraphic lines;
4. In an emergency for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
5. In the course of military training operations.

The Order will come into operation on 22nd October 1980.

Full details are contained in the Order, which may be examined together with a map showing the restricted roads and an alternative route at the County Hall, Cwmbran, during normal office hours (Monday to Friday).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from 20th October 1980, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
