### LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1976

#### *Yorkshire Water Authority Beverley and North Holderness Internal Drainage District*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 11 (1) and 109 (6) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, proposes to make an Order confirming, with a modification, a Scheme submitted to him by the Yorkshire Water Authority under section 11 (1) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, making provision for:

- (i) The amalgamation of the Beverley and Holderness Internal Drainage District and the Beverley and Barmston (Sea End) Internal Drainage District;
- (ii) The abolition of the existing Drainage Boards thereof;
- (iii) The constitution of a new Internal Drainage Board;
- (iv) Matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon.

All the rights, powers, duties, obligations and liabilities of the existing Drainage authorities will be transferred to the new Beverley and North Holderness Internal Drainage Board except those arising under any of the following acts:

1966	An Act for dividing, inclosing and draining certain Lands, Grounds and common Pastures, in the Parish of Cottingham, in the East Riding of the County of York.
1785	An Act for draining, preserving and improving certain Low Grounds and Carrs in the several parishes of Saint John in Beverley and of Skidby in the East Riding of the County of York.
1791	An Act for dividing and inclosing certain Open Fields, Land and Grounds, in the Parish of Cottingham, in the East Riding of the County of York; and for amending an Act passed in the Sixth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for dividing, inclosing and draining certain Lands, Grounds and Common Pastures, in the said Parish.
1798	The Beverley and Barmston Drainage Act 1798.

1808 An Act to alter and amend an Act passed in the twenty fifth year of the Reign of His present Majesty for draining, preserving and improving certain Low Grounds and Carrs in the several parishes of Saint John of Beverley, and of Skidby, in the East Riding of the County of York.

1880 The Beverley and Barmston Drainage Act 1880.

The Scheme affects lands in the City of Kingston-upon-Hull, and in the Boroughs of Beverley, Holderness and North Wolds in the County of Humberside.

The Scheme may affect the liability to drainage rates of properties in the areas mentioned above.

A copy of the draft Order, together with a copy of the modified Scheme and of the map referred to therein, has been deposited at the offices of the Kingston-upon-Hull City Council, Guildhall, Hull HU1 2AA, at the offices of the North Wolds Borough Council, West Garth, Driffield, Yorks, and at the offices of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Room 396, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London SW1P 2AE, for public inspection during normal office hours within the period of thirty days from the date of publication of this notice.
