DUDLEY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH

The Borough of Dudley (Thorns Road, Quarry Bank) (Experimental) (Prohibition of Driving) (Extension No. 1) Order 1980.

Notice is hereby given that on 16th October 1980, the Borough Council of Dudley, acting as agents for the County Council of West Midlands, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 9 (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, made the above-mentioned Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle to proceed:

- (a) from the south-eastern carriageway to the north-western carriageway; or
- (b) from the north-western carriageway to the south-eastern carriageway, of Thorns Road, Quarry Bank, at

its junctions with Acres Road and Brandon Way, or at the gaps in the central reservation of Thorns Road, 140 metres south-west of its junction with Brandon Way and 120 metres north-east of its junction with Caledonia.

Any vehicle proceeding in a south-easterly direction in Acres Road or Brandon Way shall, on reaching the junction of Acres Road or Brandon Way with the north-western carriageway of Thorns Road, make a left hand turn into Thorns Road.

The Order will be effective until 28th February 1981.
