

SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL

Suffolk County Council (Parish of Woodbridge) (B1438 South East Link Road and Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that Suffolk County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to:

- (i) prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the lengths and sides of road described in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (ii) restrict the waiting of vehicles on the length of road described in Schedule 2 to this notice.

These proposals will replace existing waiting restrictions in the lengths and sides of roads described in the above Schedules.

Exceptions in the Order provide for a vehicle to wait on the roads specified for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight, to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded, to enable it to be used in connection with any building or demolition operation and the maintenance of the road of the services therein.

A copy of the draft Order and a map showing the roads affected, together with a brief statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order are available for inspection during normal office hours at the Offices of the District Secretary, Suffolk Coastal District Council, Council Offices, Melton Hill, Woodbridge, and my office.

Objections to the Order, specifying the grounds on which they are made must be in writing and must reach me not later than 17th November 1980.

SCHEDULE 1

*No Waiting at Any Time***B1438 South East Link Road**

- (i) From Thoroughfare, south-easterly for 55 metres.
- (ii) From 15 metres north-west of Deben Road, south-easterly to 15 metres south-east of that junction.
- (iii) From 15 metres north-east of Hamblin Road, south-westerly to 15 metres south-west of that junction.
- (iv) On the south-eastern side, from 34 metres north-east of Quay Street, north-easterly for 82 metres.
- (v) On the north-western side, from 34 metres north-east of Quay Street, north-easterly for 158 metres.

Deben Road, from the B1438 South-East Link Road north-easterly for 20 metres.

Hamblin Road, from the B1438 South-East Link Road north-westerly for 15 metres.

Sun Lane, from Thoroughfare north-westerly for 15 metres.

Suffolk County Council (Parish of Beccles) (Fair Close and Fair Close Lane) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that Suffolk County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles, between the hours of 8 p.m. and 6 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The Swansea City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Pay and Display) Second Amendment Order 1980

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of section 84(c) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1967, and the Local Authorities' Traffic Order (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1969 that the Swansea City Council propose to amend The Swansea City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Pay and Display) Order 1977 (as amended) and the Schedule (as amended) and maps (as amended) attached thereto providing for the use of parking places in the City area and in particular this Amendment Order will provide for the inclusion within the Order of two Short-Stay Pay and Display Car Parks situate at The Old Dairy, Oystermouth and The Quarry, Oystermouth, Swansea.
