Notice is hereby given that the Buckinghamshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 72 (3), 73 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972.

When this Order comes into effect the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice will become subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. part of this length of road from a point 334 metres north-west of the centre line of its junction with Moreton Lane north-westwards for a distance of 176 metres is at present unrestricted.

CUMBRIA COUNTY COUNCIL

County of Cumbria (Class II Road B6260, Bridge Street/ Boroughgate, Appleby-in-Westmorland) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that on 17th October 1980 the Cumbria County Council made the above Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

This Order, which will come into operation on 27th October 1980, makes it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to:

(a) wait at any time in the lengths of road or on the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;

(b) wait between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice; and

(c) wait between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. for a period exceeding 2 hours on the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan showing the lengths of road concerned, may be inspected at the Public Library, Low Wiend, Appleby, and the offices of the undersigned during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 17th October 1980, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
