HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

*The Pentrebach—Dowlais Trunk Road (Improvement at Mountain Hare Side Roads) Order 19*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Order:  
an Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him—

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways
- (b) to stop up highways
- (c) to construct a new highway to connect Goat Mill Road with the Pentrebach—Dowlais Trunk Road (A4060)
- (d) to provide new means of access to premises

all at Mountain Hare aforesaid and providing for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Mid Glamorgan as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Orders and of the relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 5th November 1980 to 17th December 1980 at the Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, the offices of Mid Glamorgan County Council, County Hall, Cardiff & Merthyr Tydfil Borough Council, Town Hall, Merthyr Tydfil.

Any person may not later than 17th December 1980 object to the making of the Orders, by notice to the Secretary of State, at the Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, quoting reference WR11/5/14 and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
