

Western side, from its junction with Parade Road South to a point 55 metres north-east of that junction.

Eastern side, from its junction with Royal Terrace to a point 53 metres south-west of that junction.

SCHEDULE 2

London Road South

Western side, from a point 33 metres north-east of its junction with Rectory Road to a point 50 metres south-west of its junction with Carlton Road.
