The Sheep Variable Premium (Protection of Payments) Order 1980 Marking Requirements for Ovine Animals Brought into the United Kingdom.

The Intervention Board for Agricultural Produce hereby give notice pursuant to Article 11 of the above mentioned Order that they require the marking in accordance with this notice of all ovine animals brought into the United Kingdom from places outside the United Kingdom on or after 17th November 1980 with the following exception:

Animals listed in any permit issued by or on behalf of the Board to any person occupying land in the Republic of Northern Ireland and adjacent land in Northern Ireland, when those animals are being moved

from the first mentioned land to the second; Marking requirements under this notice shall be opera-tive until further notice, and the marking shall be done by or under the supervision of an officer authorised by or on behalf of the Board for that purpose. Marking facilities will be available at the following places and times:

house, Lancaster The mark to be applied to animals imported into the United Kingdom shall be a tattoo mark comprising two letters, and it shall be applied to the right ear.

So long as a requirement under this notice is in force in any part of the United Kingdom in respect of animals of any class, it is an offence for any person, with intent to evade the requirement, to bring an animal of that class into that part of the United Kingdom, at a place or time other than one at which facilities are available for marking the animal in accordance with the requirement. Where an animal of that class has been brought into that part of the United Kingdom it is an offence for the person in charge of the animal not to present it forthwith for marking, or for any unauthorised person to move it after it has been presented and before it has been marked.
