GWYNEDD COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Gwynedd (Restricted Roads) (Llanbedrog) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Gwynedd on 3rd November 1980 made an Order under sections 72 (3), 73 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

When this Order comes into effect on 10th November 1980 certain lengths of the A499 Pwllheli to Abersoch Road; B4413 Llanbedrog to Aberdaron Road; Lon Pin; Lon Brigwll; Beach Road; and Allt Glyn y Weddw and Lon Nant Iago will become subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. HALTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Halton District Council (Alfred Street (Part), Widnes) (Experimental Prohibition of Driving) Order 1980

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The Hampshire (Yew Tree Road, North Waltham) (Width Restriction) Order 1980
