Regulation Act 1967, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which is as follows:

(a) To prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times on the lengths and sides of roads referred to in Schedule 1 to this notice. The usual exemptions will be incorporated in the Order.

(b) To restrict waiting by vehicles during specified hours on the lengths and sides of roads referred to in Schedule 2 to this notice. The usual exemptions will be incorporated in the Order.

(c) To limit waiting by vehicles to 30 minutes in 1 hour between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Saturday on the lengths and side of the road referred to in Schedule 2 to this notice. to in Schedule 3 to this notice.

(d) To restrict the driving of vehicles through junctions where "Box" traffic signs are displayed at Balby Road, Wigston (north side) at its two junctions with Leopold

Street and Albion Street.

(e) To revoke the following Orders to the extent that they relate to the lengths and sides of roads specified in Schedule 4 to this notice:

(i) The Wigston Urban District (Various Streets)

(No. 2) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1967.

(ii) The County of Leicestershire (Various Roads, Oadby) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1971.

(iii) The Borough of Oadby and Wigston (Blaby Road, Wigston) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 15th December 1980, and relevant plans, may be inspected at the Council Offices, Station Road, Wigston, during normal office hours, and the Public Library, Sandhurst Street, Oadby.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 27th October 1980, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
