- 2. Payment of the above charges shall be indicated by the issue by a ticket machine of a ticket indicating that the charge has been paid in respect of the parking period purchased.
- 3. If a vehicle is left in a parking place for longer than the period for which payment has been made an additional charge of £10 shall be payable in respect of any period in excess of the parking period purchased.
- 4. If at any time whilst the vehicle is left in a parking place a ticket or authorised permit is not displayed on the vehicle the charge payable for parking the vehicle shall be £10.
- 5. No charge is payable for the use of the car parks specified between 7 p.m. and 8 a.m.
- 6. From the 1st April 1981, annual parking permits will be available as follows for motor cars, light goods vehicles and motor cycle combinations:
 - (a) Car Parks Nos. 4, 5, 6, 24 and 26-£8.
 - (b) Car Parks Nos. 1, 2, 3, 10, 12, 13, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, 23, 25 and 27—£15.
 - (c) Cat Park No. 20 only-£4.

The permit at (a) will not apply on Car Parks Nos. 4, 5 and 6 between 23rd May 1981, and 30th September 1981.

- 7. Current annual parking permits will be valid until their expiration on 1st April 1981.
- 8. Vehicles displaying a disabled person's orange badge will no longer be exempted from charges and time limits.
