Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirements of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of that Act or any regulations made under the said section 84C have not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made make application for the purpose to the High Court.
