- (b) West wide, from a point 73 yards north-west of its junction with Jackson's Lane to a point 9 yards south-east of its junction with Rock Street.

MACCLESFIELD BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Macclesfield (Parkway and Broadway, Wilmslow) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Cheshire County Council the Macclesfield Borough Council propose to make an Order in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit through traffic in both directions from Holly Road North to the By-pass from using Parkway and Broadway, Wilmslow.

A copy of the proposed Order, statement of reasons and map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be inspected during normal office hours at the Service Centre, Town Hall, Macclesfield, the Service Centre, Council Offices, South Drive, Wilmslow and during normal opening hours at the Public Library, Park Green, Macclesfield and the Public Library, South Drive, Wilmslow.

SANDWELL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Sandwell Borough Council (Access Way Connecting Leacroft Grove and Witton Lane, West Bromwich) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the Sandwell Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with the County Council of West Midlands, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, have made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in the Access Way connecting Leacroft Grove and Witton Lane, West Bromwich.

The alternative route for vehicles travelling along Witton Lane, West Bromwich in a south-easterly direction and wishing to gain access into Leacroft Grove, West Bromwich, is: turn right into Coles Lane, West Bromwich and then right again into Leacroft Grove, West Bromwich and vice-versa for vehicles wishing to gain access into Witton Lane from Leacroft Grove.

The Order was made on 7th November 1980, and comes into effect on 12th November 1980.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the restrictions are available at my offices at the Town Hall, West Bromwich, where they may be examined during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 12th November 1980, apply to the High Court for that purpose.

SOUTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The South Yorkshire County Council (Various Roads at Sheffield) (Area No. 6) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that on 5th November 1980 the South Yorkshire County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and section 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on the 27th November 1980 will be to revoke the Orders specified in the Schedule to this notice but the provisions contained in those Orders will remain in force, unchanged by virtue of the new Order.

The existing exceptions will apply in respect of the waiting restrictions.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 5th November 1980 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
