**STOCKPORT METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL**

*The Trunk Road (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. ) Abatement Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that the Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of their powers under section 63 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974, on 17th October 1980 made the Metropolitan Borough of Stockport (No. 2) Noise Abatement Order 1980.

The general affect of the Order if confirmed will be to enable the Council to control noise from premises of the following classes by establishing the current noise levels and using these as reference levels for the control of noise from the premises in the future:

- (i) Industrial premises (including garages at which repairs are undertaken)
- (ii) Places of entertainment.

The boundaries of the area covered by the Order are Dialstone Lane, New Zealand Road, Stockport Road, Peak Forest Canal, Green Lane, and Dooley Lane, Torkington Brook, the disused railway line, the boundary with Macclesfield Metropolitan Borough and the A6 London Road.

The area covered by the Order is shown coloured green on the map attached to the Order and the premises affected at the date thereof are edged red on the map. The Order will become operative twelve months from the date of confirmation by the Secretary of State.
