NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971, SECTION 210

*The Medina Borough Council (Public Footpath No. 47
Newport) Public Path Diversion Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 5th November 1980, the Medina Borough Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert the section of public footpath N.47 running from a point on the northern side of Petticoat Lane, Newport, approximately 70 metres from its eastern end, in a north-westerly direction for approximately 115 metres to a point where it will be intersected by a proposed new roadway, to a line running from a point approximately 10 metres west of its original junction point running generally in a north-westerly direction for approximately 110 metres parallel with the original path line, which will at no point be separated by more than 18 metres, but following a meandering route, to join the existing footpath at a point where it is intersected by the proposed new roadway.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Council's offices at 17 Quay Street, Newport, Isle of Wight, between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. and between 2 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

This Order becomes operative as from the date on which it is certified by the Medina Borough Council that the provisions of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with but, if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he may under section 244 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, within 6 weeks from 15th November 1980, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

Norfolk Structure Plan

ROTHERHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Rotherham Borough Council (Aston-cum-Aughton) (No.
6) Public Path Diversion Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 5th November 1980 the Rotherham Borough Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public right of way shown by a bold black line on the map included in the Order running from point A at the rear of No. 1 Ikley Crescent, Swallownest, travelling south of 282 metres to point B and then south-east for 64 metres to point C, which is situate at the north-east corner of the Swallownest Sewage Works and adjacent to an unnamed stream; to a line shown by bold black dashes on the map included in the Order, from point A travelling in a south-easterly direction for 76 metres to point D thence in a southerly direction for 70 metres to point E, the diverted footpath then travels approximately 26 metres to point F which is adjacent to the unnamed stream and thence in a southerly direction for 204 metres along the west bank of the unnamed stream to point C where it rejoins the route of the existing footpath.
