The Hartlepool Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places/Green Street HGV Park) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the Hartlepool Borough Council in exercise of their powers under section 31 (1), (2) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1968, as amended and of all other enabling powers with the consent of the County Council of Cleveland in accordance with section 28 (A), (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, propose to make an Order to control the use of the parking place named in the Schedule to this Notice, which shows the class for vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum period for waiting proposed for each parking place.

HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County of Hereford and Worcester (City Walls Road/Sidbury, Worcester) (Box Junction) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Hereford and Worcester propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to provide a "yellow box" marking at the City Walls Road/Sidbury junction, Worcester.

No vehicle shall be driven into the boxed area and thereafter driven in such a direction that it becomes necessary, owing to the presence of stationary vehicles, for any part of the vehicle to remain at rest within the box area, unless:

- (1) the driver of a vehicle is intending to turn and is prevented from doing so only by the presence of stationary vehicles provided it is waiting in a convenient position;
- (2) the direction or permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden has been obtained;
- (3) the vehicle is in use for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; and
- (4) the vehicle, the driver of which when entering the boxed area had reasonable cause to believe that he would immediately be able to drive the vehicle out of the area.

A copy of the Order as made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at the Worcester City Council Offices, Guildhall, Worcester, and at the County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, during normal office hours.

HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Bransford Road, Bromyard Road and Boughton Avenue, Worcester) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that on 14th November 1980 the County Council of Hereford and Worcester made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive, on the following sides of lengths of roads:

- (i) Bromyard Road, north side, from a point 18 metres (59 feet) west of the centre line of the railway bridge for a distance of 123 metres (403 feet) in an easterly direction;
- (ii) Bromyard Road, south side, from a point 9 metres (30 feet) west of the centre line of the railway bridge in an easterly direction to its junction with Boughton Avenue;
- (iii) Boughton Avenue, west side, from its junction with Bromyard Road for a distance of 30 metres (98 feet) in a southerly direction;
- (iv) Bransford Road, both sides, from a point 15 metres (49 feet) west of the eastern junction with Newland Crescent for a distance of 225 metres (738 feet) in an easterly direction.

The Order will come into operation on 18th November 1980. A copy of the Order as made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, from Monday to Friday inclusive during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act of 1967 or of any regulations
