If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Act Regulation 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of this notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.
