The Enfield (Weight Restriction) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council on 17th November 1980 made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974, so as to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the Enfield (Weight Restriction) (No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 1979.

2. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any goods vehicle the unladen weight of which exceeds 3 tons from entering any street or length of street specified in the Schedule to this Notice, hereinafter referred to as a "prescribed street".

3. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply:

- to any person causing any vehicle to enter any prescribed street for the purpose of gaining access to or leaving any land or premises abutting thereon or accessible only therefrom; or
- in relation to any vehicle when used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for that vehicle to enter any prescribed street; or
- in relation to any vehicle being used in connection with the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, cleansing or lighting of any prescribed street or any street accessible only therefrom, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer thereunder or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line thereunder or thereon, or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign thereon; or
- to any thing done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
- in respect of anything done in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed in the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

The Hillingdon (Prescribed Route) (No. 4) Traffic Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council on 17th November 1980 made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The general effect of the Order would be further to amend the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that in Booker Road:

- waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
- waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
