2. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit vehicles in Telford Road from entering Tewkesbury Terrace.

3. Exemption has been provided in the Order in respect of anything done :

- (a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform ;
- (b) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

4. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 24th November 1980, can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made in Room B.21, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

6. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirement of that section of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose of the High Court.
