MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

Mid Glamorgan County Council (Greenfield Terrace, North Cornelly) (Variation and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980.

Notice is hereby given that on 12th November 1980 the Mid Glamorgan County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is:

- (i) To introduce prohibition of waiting at any time on the north western side of Greenfield Terrace, North Cornelly, from a point opposite the common boundary

of Numbers 11 and 13 Greenfield Terrace, north-eastwards for a distance of 30 metres (33 yards).

- (ii) To vary the provision contained in Article 3 of the "Mid Glamorgan County Council (Greenfield Terrace and Heol-y-Parc, North Cornelly) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977" (which prohibits the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 3 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday) so as to be consistent with the proposal outlined in (i).

With regard to (i) above, exemptions are provided in the Order for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and roadworks, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

The Order came into operation on 21st November 1980 and a copy thereof and a map showing the side of length of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours until the end of 6 weeks from 21st November 1980.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act as so amended or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 21st November 1980, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

New Traffic Controls for the County of South Glamorgan

Notice is hereby given that on the 18th November 1980, the County Council of South Glamorgan in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 31, 35, 36, 39, 72, 73 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968, the Local Government Act, 1972 and the Road Traffic Act 1974 made Orders, the general effect of which is to impose traffic restrictions on the lengths of road referred to in column 1 of the Schedule below. The nature of the restriction is shown in column 2.

The Orders come into operation on 24th November 1980 and their titles are shown in column 3 of the Schedule.

Copies of the Orders and plans showing the affected areas are available at the address shown below, where they may be examined during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of any of the Orders or any provision contained therein on the ground that they are not within the powers conferred by the Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, you may, within 6 weeks from the 18th November 1980, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
