**GWENT COUNTY COUNCIL**

*The Gwent County Council (Various Roads, Crindau, Newport) (Weight Restriction) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that the Gwent County Council, in exercise of their powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967 propose to make the above order the effect of which will be:

To prohibit any vehicle, the unladen weight of which exceeds 3 tons, from proceeding in those lengths of road as set out in the schedule to this notice.

Exemptions will be provided in the order to permit access to the affected roads for the following purposes.

1. the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to those lengths of road as set out in the schedule.
2. for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to those lengths of road, or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land.
3. in connection with any building operation, or demolition in or adjacent to those lengths of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those lengths of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to those lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.
4. in the course of military training operations.
5. for firebrigade, police or ambulance purposes.

The alternative route is via Aragon Street and Albany Street.

A copy of the proposed Order, a map showing the affected roads and an alternative route, together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the order, may be inspected at the offices of the Newport Borough Council, Civic Centre, Newport, and the County Hall, Cwmbran, Gwent.
